The Address Atlas Grid is spatially identical to the Zone atlas grid in that it divides the Albuquerque Metropolitan Area into square mile tiles and is a common way of describing a general location in the City. Each tile containing area within the City of Albuquerque with assigned addresses contains a link to the corresponding page of the Address Atlas in PDF format. The Address Atlas PDF page is designed to print at 8.5 X 11.

### ***Why was the Dataset Created?***

The Address Atlas Grid was created to divide the Albuquerque Metro Area into square mile tiles in order to publish the Address Atlas map in a usable paper size and scale.

### ***How was the Dataset Created?***

The KMZ file was created from polygons that divide the Albuquerque Metropolitan Area into square miles. The PDFs were created from data driven pages designed in ArcGIS software.
